



Three Years Milestone - A long way


How may I start the discription of this wonderful way of success? Perhaps so. Once there were two people who decided to make a mag. Or so. Two heroic men decided to start a big adventure, to produce an own mag. Their names were Michael (everybody knows him) and Ronald Saame. Michael wanted to make a computer mag and Saame wanted to make a sports mag and so it came, that in the first issue (release date 8/89) were two gametests (Microprose Soccer and a production from Michael, The Tennis Game), one article about a group(?), Scheck (Michael didn't like him because he also had a PD-Shop, you surely can imagine, that Michael wrote no good things about him). There was also one picture(!) On this picture was Scheck shown before a wall (a circle with eyes and a lot of dots in the face) and one article about the footballmatch Darmstadt vs Stuttgart (from Saame). You ask whether that was all? Yes, that was all! One side - that was enough. But the next issue came already two days later. The three people who read the mag (Michael, Saame and a person I don't know) had decided that on the big mag market was a place for "MM's Aktueller Softmarkt". With the second issue the mag got also a new name, namely "Der CSV Bote" (C for Computer, S for Sport and V for Video). This issue already had 3 sides. I spare my time to list all articles which were printed. Interesting is perhaps that Michael wrote 90% of the mag (the rest Saame) and that the second side was only on the left side printed. On the other side stood in big letters that there normally would have been a video-test, but because Markus Schneider (his father was the man who copied the mag) hadn't wrote quick enough, there was nothing. On 18.2.89 (Oh yes, at that time it goes punch on punch). In this issue appeared for the first time "Robert's Essen in Deutschland" (Robert is Michael's brother). Arkanoid got the Hit-Sign from Michael (the first game, which had reached that). In the advertisements offers Torsten Hartmann (perhaps known coz of his Kino Corner) everyone who punches Scheck in his face, 5 DM. That was all, what I can write about this issue? We can skip the next issue because there was nothing, which is interesting now. In the next issue (5/89) Michael tested Ultima V with the question: Game of the year 89? At the end he awarded Ultima the title "Adventure of the year 1989". In this issue was for the first time the Hitline. In the next "The first great Basic-Kurs" began. The game

"Summer Olympiad" was a Flop. The next issue was the begin of a great career. T Michelmann (me) wrote the first letter to the editorship of the "CSV Bote". I think Michael was unconscious for a long time about that shock about a reaction of a reader from his mag! Never before somebody had written a letter to the editor. I was the first (Yes, I'm a bit proud of that). Apart from this great event in the issue no. 7/89 was there also the begin from the computer joke encyclopedia, named "Komm-piu-tern". Just like the book from that Michael copied the text. Before I forget, I suggested in my letter to give the "CSV Bote" a new name, "CFV Bote" (C=Computer, F=Soccer (Fußball in german), V=Video), because all the sportarticles in the mag were about soccer. And so Michael suggested me to write articles. So it came, that in the issue No. 8/89 was the first article from me! It handled about the great tennis tournament in Paris (French Open). This issue was the first (and temporary also the last) in which both sides of the pages were printed and it was the first (and also the last) issue in which there was an article about a game for Atari ST. Michael wrote an article about the origin of the "CSV-Boten", the title was "From the diary of a chef-editor". If the mag is really produced in this way... than good night. I will give you a small insight now: "13. June: (...) Total enervated I gave pressure to T.S., C.M. (he could choose, death or article) and by T.M. (menaceletter). Concerning P.L., only the threat of a carbomb in the lift helped to force him writing articles." And so on... With the next issue the readers had problems. It was so bad copied, that you could read some parts of the mag only bad or simply couldn't read them. The edition was during that by 30. In this issue I wrote my first game test (Fugger). The editorship was enlarged by Dave (I think everybody knows him). The next issue, the mag was now named "C&V Bote". How I had suggested some issues before, it was "only for members of the club". Club means that Michael had opened a PD-Club and only the members of this club got this issue. Except from this, there was nothing what is important. Oh... wait a moment there was an important thing: I became an editor! Now I was on the same step like Michael (Sorry, but that must be said).






How much sides? And again a development

Three Years Milestone - A long way


-A review on our history-

The issue No.11/89 was again for members of the club. In this issue we had many hits, like Oil Imperium and Grand Monster Slam. The next issue was again only for members of the club! Hey, I didn't know that it lasts for such a long time! In this issue was only one hit, oohh! Stunt Car Racer. And we got a new editor: Jens Neumann (jnm). At least: nothing special. Not longer "Only for members of the club" was the next issue, which was in colour! Only one colour (red), but in colour. In this issue we had big problems to get games to test, and so we tested a game named River Raid (I think everybody knows the game. I believe it was spreaded in 1984...) This issue was something special: it was for the first time, that we got paid advertisements. Michael searched people who would paint covers for our great mag... he a build up a competition. And it was for the first time, that the "C&V Bote" cost something: namely 50pf. 50pf was also the price for the next issue which was spreaded on 1.290. In this issue Michael decided to print the rating key (how he said: more for the editors than for the readers, because the editors gave sometimes curious points. In the issue No.11/89 for example. A certain tom gave the game Buffalo Bill's Wild West Rodeo Show the rating Graphic: 98, Sound 100, Order of Events: 97, Motivation: 98 and Price/Performance 99. I think that comments itself). The next issue was a great step in direction to become professionell. Our mag was now in DIN A5 format and with a cover (A picture from Dave). It got an editorial and Michael had bought the programm Printfox. With this programm Michael could now design the mag much better and easier. In this issue was also shown, how to install a reset on your 64'er and how to install a write/read lamp on your 1541. And in this issue was for the first time a rubric "News and Gossip". The next time was an hard time for our mag. Two weeks before the next issue nobody knew whether it would ever give again a "C&V Bote". But Michael decided (luckily, how I can say now) that it will exists for the next hundred years! In this issue Michael installed the impressum on the last side and our mag costed now 1,50 DM (300% climbed). Yes, yes the inflation... The next issue costed only 1DM. The edition of our mag climbed to 100 pieces and it was now printed by a print-shop. On the second side, which was blank the time since the mag was produced in DIN A5, were now the contents. In the issue No.11/12-90 we must use the same cover like in our first issue that was printed in DIN A5. Sad, but true. Three sides full of paid advertisements took much of stress away from Michael. Michael wrote in this issue an article about "Play by mails" (Postspiele) and thm wrote for the first

time his "Kino-Corner". And so on.. In the next issue, the No. 1/2-91, we had two hits: Rings of Medusa and Lords of Doom. In this issue was for the first time the joke corner with jokes about a car called "Manta" and about the Atari ST. I'm sure that you don't know how happy I'm now... only four issues yet about which I must write! Under the editorial of the next issue was a photo, on which two of our editors are looking TV. The extraordinary? They wear 3D-glasses on their noses and got beer bottles (Schmucker) in their hands. For our readers who don't know what the german TV shows, where you can use 3D-glasses: There is a strip show named "Tutti Frutti" and another programm (Leo's Magazin). They said both that they'd looked that other programm, but I doubt on that. Apart from this photo in this issue were also tests, jokes, the evaluation of the Votesheet from the last issue... I didn't mention that? Sorry! Ok, let's go on. Pmn started to write his Demo (P)Reviews and on the last two sides was an IBM-Corner. With the next issue our edition climbed on 350 pieces. Yes we made it, we are now in the scene!!! The effect was that we had a report of the Horizon Easter Party, much of gametests and more as one side "News and Gossip". Not to forget the printing quality of our mag climbed about 100%, because Michael discovered that my printer can print in the NLO-Mode of Printfox. With the next issue the mag changed again his name, and was now named MILESTONE. With the name changed also the contents a bit. Now there weren't as much gametests as before but more reports about other things. For example the reports about the copy partys from Elicma and from Bochum. Besides that a report with the sonorous name "...and they come to fetch you", where a scene dude described his experience with the police. And now, after more than 9 hours of recherching in old issues and in my dictionary and writing it is nearly made. Now I will describe you the last issue. The last issue was the first, which was written in English. As special highlights were in this issue an interview with the great Chaos Computer Club. We are the first mag, that managed to get an interview with the leader of this overall known club. Other reports handled about Venlo, Bocholt and also another interview, this time with Exorcist of Chaos. A new chapter named "Did you know, that" was presented. Yeah, it's done! The first great review ends. I hope you liked it and the text was a bit entertaining (and not so hard to read). Now I must say good bye for the moment. I wish you a wonderful day with our anniversary issue. Good bye



How much articles the editors wrote





How much articles the editors wrote





How much sides the editors wrote





How much sides the editors wrote








Bonzai-Party


